Portugal operates one of Europe's most successful Digital Nomad Visa systems through the D8 Visa program.

- Accommodation proof
- Health insurance
- Criminal background certificate



## Minimum Savings Requirement

Portugal also requires applicants to demonstrate financial reserves.

## Estimated Required Savings (2026)

Applicant Type	Required Savings
Single Applicant	€25,000
Spouse / Partner	Additional €8,520
Each Child	Additional €5,132

These funds are usually expected to be available in a Portuguese or European bank account before the residence permit appointment.

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## Accommodation Investment

Applicants must provide proof of accommodation in Portugal. This may include:

- Long-term rental agreement
  - Property lease
  - Property ownership
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## Residency Options

Portugal offers:

- Temporary Stay Visa (up to 1 year)
- Residence Visa leading to renewable permits and citizenship eligibility

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## Spain

Spain introduced its Digital Nomad Visa under the Startup Law framework.

### Minimum Monthly Income Requirement

Applicants must prove stable and recurring income from foreign employers, freelance contracts, or overseas business activities.

### Estimated Income Requirement

Single Applicant	€2,762–€2,849
Spouse / First Dependent	Additional €690–€1,068
Each Additional Dependent	Additional €305–€356

The exact amount varies slightly depending on how the Spanish authorities calculate the national minimum wage (SMI).



**Income may come from:**

- Remote employment
- Freelance contracts
- Foreign company ownership
- Consulting services
- Online businesses
- International clients

**Applicants must generally demonstrate:**

- 3+ months of working relationship with foreign employer or clients
- Employer existence for at least 1 year
- Stable recurring income documentation

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**Savings and Financial Reserves**

Although Spain focuses mainly on monthly income, maintaining substantial savings strengthens the application significantly.

**Recommended Savings**

Single Applicant	€25,000–€30,000
Family Applicants	€30,000–€50,000+

Savings may also compensate for small income gaps in some applications. Community discussions and immigration practitioners frequently report successful cases where savings supported borderline income situations.
